—PROGRAM POLICIES—

- ◆ Participants must choose a consistent plan of Wednesdays OR Sundays
 - ◆ Limited make-ups on alternate day may be considered, but must be pre-scheduled with director approval
- ◆ Included Practice ice benefit is designed to be used weekly; limited rollover
 - ◆ Private lessons are not mandatory, but encouraged
(Private instruction fees are separate and payable to private coach of choice)
- ◆ Participate in at least one Club Performance event, such as the Holiday Recital, a Spring Show Group #, Exhibition, or Basic Skills Competition
 - ◆ Participation in Compete USA Events
at Skate Wilmington or Autumn Skate Competitions is encouraged
- ◆ Program benefits include LTS USA Membership, with the option of adding at cost, a USFS Introductory or other membership at any time
