## **Skate Wilmington 2020 COVID-19 Restrictions**

## As of 7-19-2020

It is our primary concern to keep our skaters, coaches, officials, staff and guests as safe as possible during these challenging times. The competition will look different from previous years, but we aim to provide you a safe, pleasant, and fun competitive environment. Please note the following restrictions will be in place the duration of our competition.

- 1) Face masks <u>must</u> be worn in the building at all times by all skaters, guests, coaches and officials. Skaters may remove their mask during warm-up and while they compete. After skaters complete their program, their mask must be put back on.
- 2) Everyone must use the hand sanitizer when entering and exiting the building. Everyone must use the assigned entrance and exit at the front of the building.
- 3) Each skater will only be allowed ONE parent or guest in addition to their coach. The State of Delaware has imposed limitations on how many people can be in the building.
- 4) There will be no use of locker rooms. Skaters must come dressed to compete. Bathrooms are not to be used for changing. Only the bathrooms at the Skate Rental end of the rink may be used by skaters, coaches and guests.
- 5) Chairs with ample social distance will be provided for each skater to put their skates on at the side of the rink. Their guest may sit in that chair as the skater goes to warm-up and compete. Chairs and surrounding area will be sanitized after each skater/guest leaves.
- 6) Skaters and guests will be expected to leave the building as soon as practical after their performance. This is necessary to allow time for proper cleaning of your chair area before use by the next skater. We understand you may wish to stay and watch your friends skate, but that is not possible under the current restrictions.
- 7) Skating orders and results will be posted online.
- 8) Social distancing must be maintained. Please comply with the signage throughout the building.
- 9) There will be no awards ceremonies. Medals may be picked up at Registration. There will be an area to take pictures on the awards stand.
- 10) The upstairs lounge is restricted to officials and staff only. No skaters, coaches or guests are allowed upstairs. Warm ups should be done outside.
- 11) Temperature checks may be taken.
- 12) No jackets, tissues or water bottles may be place on the boards around the ice surface. It is strongly suggested you bring your own water bottles.
- 13) There will be no vendors except the videographer.
- 14) Cleaning will be done throughout the building during the day as well as at the conclusion of the events for the day.
- 15) We are sorry, but at this time there can be no couples/duet events due to social distancing requirements.
- 16) Café will meet the requirements of Delaware state guidelines at the time of the competition.
- 17) There will be no critiques onsite at the competition. We are considering options for email feedback after the competition.
- 18) Those who are feeling sick, coughing or sneezing should remain home. You should take your temperature at home and evaluate that you are not showing any signs of COVID-19 prior to leaving your home.
- 19) Wash hand frequently for at least 20 seconds with soap and water.
- 20) Those who have been diagnosed with COVID-19 (or are awaiting test results) or have come in contact with anyone that tested positive for COVID-19 within 21 days of the competition should remain home.
- 21) No items may be thrown on the ice for skaters.
